Night with the Saints: Due to the Lenten Mission, Night with the Saints will be **postponed**. Look for the new date to be announced.

Parish Mission: This year's Lenten Mission will be given by Fr. Joseph Portzer, FSSP. It will begin today, Passion Sunday, April 7th at 7:00 PM and continue every night at 7:00 PM through Wednesday, April 10th. Holy Mass will be said at 6:00 PM, Monday - Wednesday. Confessions will be heard after each Mission sermon while the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.

Pro-Life Movie in Theaters: Fr. Gordon would like to recommend the movie **Unplanned**, the true story of the former Planned Parenthood Employee of the Year and Abortion clinic director, Abby Johnson, who became a pro-life advocate. The movie is powerful, and depicts well, both pro-lifers who always left the door for her conversion open (which was crucial to her conversion), and those few pro-lifers whose imprudence was not helpful to the cause of converting those attempting abortions. A key takeaway from Abby's experience as clinic director – she revealed that Planned Parenthood's own statistics show that when people are praying in front of abortion mills, their abortion "no show" rate is always high, sometimes 75%. Many lives are saved by praying outside of these clinics! **A word of caution:** the movie does depict abortions, wherein one can see what is visible when a woman is wearing short shorts, in case one is easily tempted by that.

40 Days for Life: *40 Days for Life* is a focused pro-life campaign with a vision to access God's power through prayer, fasting and peaceful vigil to end abortion. It consists of a 24 hour vigil lasting 40 days at an abortion clinic. There is a campaign going on right now at the nearby Planned Parenthood abortion clinic. At the link below one can see which hours are not yet covered to sign up to pray for an hour. Saturday morning, April 13th only has one hour covered, and Saturdays are their busiest times for abortions. Thank you for praying and fasting for an end to abortion. *Fr. Gordon*

*We ask that parishioners request no more than three Mass intentions per priest at one time.


