## APOLOGETICS CORNER

*Defending our Faith with the Truth*

# Why the True Church is the Catholic Church!

**Q**uestion: “There are so many different Christian churches out there! Mormons, Jehovah’s Witnesses, Evangelicals... How do you Catholics know that yours is the right Christian church?”

**A**nswer: “Excellent question! Wouldn’t the right Christian Church—the Lord’s Church—be the one that perfectly agrees with the Bible? So let’s look in the Word of God!

“According to the Bible, ‘being born again’ actually means “being baptized,” with water (“born again of water and the Holy Ghost,” as we read in John 3:5). This is “the washing of regeneration” (i.e. being born again) spoken of in Titus 3:5.

“According to the Bible, Baptism is what the Lord uses to save us (1 Peter 3:20-21: “baptism... saveth you”)

“According to the Bible, the Lord’s plan for how He wants to forgive our sins is to give His forgiveness through certain men (John 20:23: “whose sins you forgive they are forgiven, whose sins you retain they are retained”; 2 Corinthians 5:18-20: certain “ambassadors”, ambassadors even to other Christians, have been given “the ministry of reconciliation” from “sins”). This entails confessing those sins to those ‘ambassadors’ - the priests (James 5:14-16, 1 John 1:9)

“According to the Bible, the ministry (the priesthood) is passed on by imposing hands on certain men (1 Timothy 4:14)—this means that to be a minister, one must have had hands imposed on him by someone authorized to do so (see Titus 1:5), giving him a personally handed on link to the Apostles for this very ministry.

“According to the Bible, it was foretold that the Lord’s Church would have priests (Isaiah 66:21), and have a hierarchy that “God has set” to “govern” the Church

(1 Corinthians 12:28).

“According to the Bible, if a minister is to be truly undivided in his service to God, he should be unmarried (1 Corinthians 7:32-33), just as St. Paul was unmarried (1 Corinthians 7:8), for this celibacy gives one “power to attend upon the Lord without impediment” (1 Corinthians 7:35). Therefore we should expect the priests of God’s Church to be un-married.

“These characteristics which Our Lord’s Church should have are described in the Bible. But Mormons don’t believe that God forgives through the ministry of a priest, nor in a celibate priesthood (they also don’t believe that the Holy Ghost is a Divine Person of the Holy Trinity, equal to God the Father and God the Son).

“Jehovah’s Witnesses don’t believe in forgiveness of sins through the ministry of a priest, nor do they believe in an ordained priesthood, nor in celibacy for its ministers (they also don’t believe that Jesus is of the same Divine Nature as God the Father).

“Evangelical Christians don’t believe that baptism saves, nor in forgiveness of sins through the ministry of a priest, nor in the ordained priesthood, nor in a hierarchy of government for God’s Church nor in celibacy for the ministers of God.

“Only one Christian Church has all of the characteristics from the Bible which Our Lord’s Church should have—the oldest Christian community—the Roman Catholic Church. So come be a part of the Lord’s Church!”

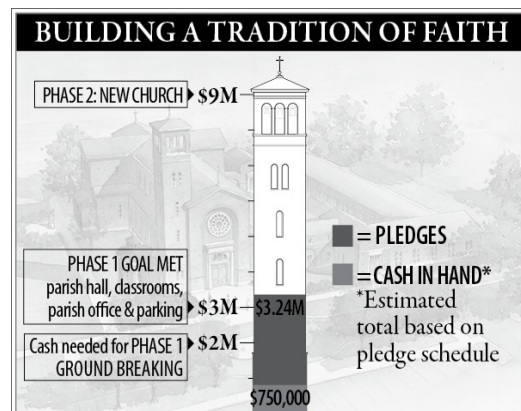
