

Fr. Flick's Mass intentions: are private this week.

Fr. Gordon will be on sabbatical during February, March, and April. During that time, he will not have access to emails, phone, or texts. Please keep him in your prayers.

Daily Mass time change: Beginning Feb 6, daily Mass times (Monday—Saturday) will be 6:30 am **and 8:00 am**. There will no longer be a 12:15 daily Mass. We understand this will be a change for some, but this schedule is better for both the priests and faithful to begin with Holy Mass the first thing in the morning. It is harder on the priest when he cannot begin his day and routine with the Holy Mass. (Many may not be aware that in the old code of Canon Law, it was forbidden for Mass to start after 12 Noon. Granted, this is not the law anymore but it puts the proper emphasis on the importance of placing Holy Mass first in your day). There will still be evening Masses for special occasions and sung Masses in order to allow the faithful to meet their obligations. This will also bring the daily consistency desired by the priests and requested by many of the survey respondents. We appreciate your flexibility, please make note of this change.
