Daily Mass time change: Beginning Feb 6, daily Mass times (Monday—Saturday) will be 6:30 am **and 8:00 am**. There will no longer be a 12:15 daily Mass. We understand this will be a change for some, but this schedule is better for both the priests and faithful to begin with Holy Mass first thing in the morning. It is harder on the priest when he cannot begin his day & routine with the Holy Mass. (Many may not be aware that in the old code of Canon Law, it was forbidden for Mass to start after 12 Noon. Granted, this is not the law anymore but it puts the proper emphasis on the importance of placing Holy Mass first in your day). This will also bring the daily consistency desired by the priests & requested by many of the survey respondents. There will still be evening Masses for special occasions &sung Masses in order to allow the faithful to meet their obligations. We appreciate your flexibility; please make note of this change. Thank you.

Evening Masses: Thursday, February 2 at 6:30 pm, Sung Mass and procession for the Purification of the BVM; Ash Wednesday, February 22, 6:30 pm Mass. **Adoration/Benediction cancelled:** on Thursday, Feb. 2, due to the 6:30 pm Sung Mass that evening.
