A Note from Fr. Gordon: Praised be Jesus Christ. I want to *thank* everyone for the notes of tremendous support I have received: the 100 Rosaries from the choir, the many expressions of gratitude and prayers, etc. It means so much to me. *I miss you all, but I pray for you every day.*

I also need to say that two weeks had not gone by before Fr. Flick received an *anonymous* letter criticizing him. If you have an issue with a priest (or anyone), don't take the coward's way and criticize priests or others behind their back (on parish Signal groups, other social media or otherwise) nor send *anonymous* criticisms. *People who have no idea what health issues the priests deal with that affect their ministry especially* have no business submitting anonymous criticisms of them or making cowardly criticisms of them to others. It's been done to me plenty, but for my part I don't read anonymous criticisms: if there is no name, I throw it out unread.

I have heard some say that the Fraternity burns out its priests, but on the contrary, it is parishioners like these who burn out priests. I am *not* saying this is the majority of you; many persons *are* prayerfully supportive of the priests, and we **thank you** for that, but then there are the unjust criticisms... There is need rather to pray for priests and be spiritually supportive in these times rather than be criticizing. (For those of you who listen to Fr. Ripperger, he had a talk about this recently in which he stated the faithful would lose their good priests as a punishment from God for their attacks upon them and they would be left with few and bad priests.) If anything will undo this parish, it is creating dissension by cowardly gossip (not only about the priests), and people not minding their own business. *I am aware of what Fr. Flick deals with, I have never heard him complain about his particular cross, and I think Fr. Flick is doing a fine job: I trust him with the parish unreservedly.* Fr. Gordon.

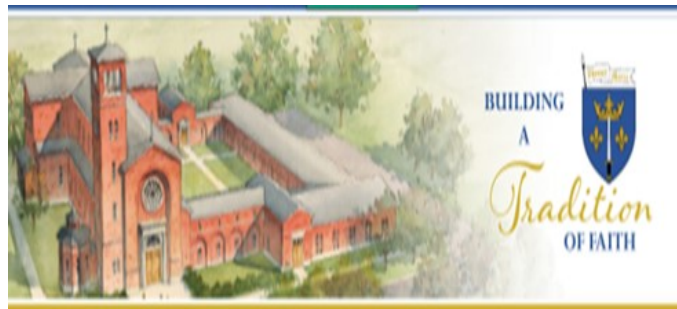
