Traditional Reverences: (a reminder from Fr. Gordon) a slight bowing of one's head was customarily done when the crucifix passes during the entrance procession at Holy Mass. Although not forbidden, the slight head bow was traditionally **not done** when the priest passes by in procession or leaves the altar after Mass. When the priest passes by carrying the Blessed Sacrament, the custom is that all should kneel till the Blessed Sacrament has passed by.
