**Office closed:** the parish office will be closed Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Monday.

**Catechism class:** Classes will be cancelled Monday April 3 (Holy Week) and April 10 (Easter week). Classes will resume **Monday April 17**.

**Exploring Catholicism class:** will resume Thursday April 13.

**Holy Week:** All meetings are cancelled during Holy Week.

**Donuts cancelled:** the coffee and donuts social time after Sunday Masses is cancelled for Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday.

**Fewer confession times for Holy Week:** as there will only be two priests for Holy Week, confessions will be limited at this very busy & holy season of the Church year. **There will not be confessions before Mass for the 3 days of the Triduum and there will not be the usual 4 pm confession on Holy Saturday.** Please plan ahead and come to confession **before** Holy Thursday. Thank you.

**Triduum schedule:** Holy Thursday 6 pm; Good Friday 3 pm; Holy Saturday 6 pm.

**Good Friday:** is the day we remember Our Lord's Passion and Death. It is meant to be a day of prayerful **silence** and recollection. In tradition, it is most appropriate to spend the time after the Good Friday Liturgy in prayerful and **silent** consideration of the mysteries we have just commemorated. It is not an appropriate time for visiting or social activity. We ask that you leave the church in prayerful **silence** after the service. Have a blessed and holy Triduum!

**First Communion:** if your child has not made their First Communion, will be 7 yrs. or older by May 20 and are not in Anne Marie Vogel's First Communion prep class that meets on Monday evening, please contact the parish office to be added to the group email.

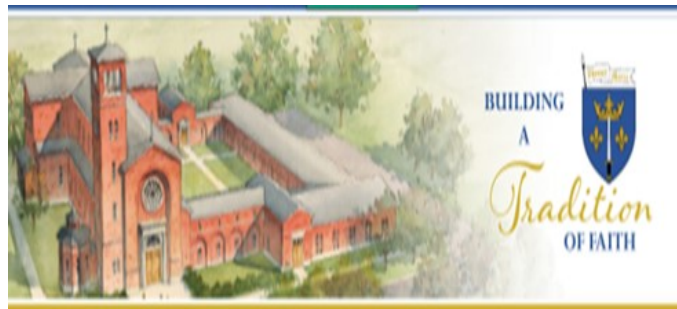
