**Modesty at church:** As hot summer weather approaches, please follow the Church's teachings on modesty and help your children to do the same. These standards state: "In order that uniformity of understanding prevail... **a dress cannot be called decent which is cut deeper than two fingers' breadth below the pit of the throat**, which does not cover the arms at least to the elbows, **and scarcely reaches a bit beyond the knees**. Furthermore, dresses of transparent materials are improper." Therefore, ***dresses should be long enough to easily cover the knees even while seated***. Clothing should conceal, not reveal. Thank you for observing these Vatican standards! May God reward and bless you.

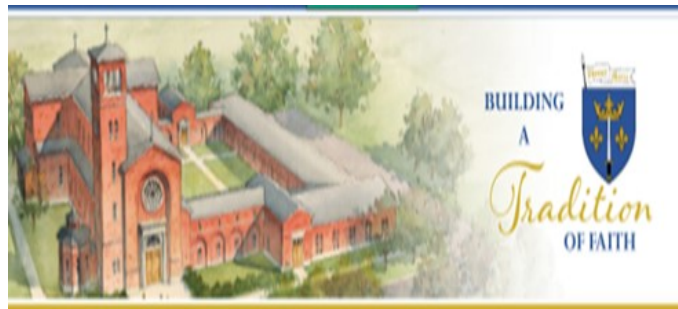
