

Modesty at church: As hot summer weather approaches, please follow the Church's teachings on modesty and help your children to do the same. These standards state: "In order that uniformity of understanding prevail... **a dress cannot be called decent which is cut deeper than two fingers' breadth below the pit of the throat**, which does not cover the arms at least to the elbows, **and scarcely reaches a bit beyond the knees**. Furthermore, dresses of transparent materials are improper." Therefore, **dresses should be long enough to *easily cover the knees even while seated***. Clothing should conceal, not reveal. Thank you for observing these Vatican standards! May God reward and bless you.

Pro Life Rosary: The Pro Life Group of St. Joan of Arc will meet Saturday June 17 at noon in front of Planned Parenthood in Spokane (123 E. Indiana Ave.) to recite 15 decades of the Most Holy Rosary to end legalized abortion everywhere.
