

#### Fr. James Buckley's obituary

Fr. James Bartholomew Buckley was born on November 29, 1937, in New York City. His parents, JohnFrancis Buckley and Mary Catherine Lyons were Irish immigrants from County Galway.

He attended St. Luke's grade school in the south Bronx, graduating in June 1951. In the fall of 1951, he entered Mother of the Savior, a Junior Seminary run by the Salvatorian Fathers in Blackwood, New Jersey. After graduating in May 1957, he
