Notes from Fr. Rapoport:

Mass intentions are open: Please make checks out to St. Joan of Arc and submit your Mass intentions to the office, the black box at the back of church, or by mail. Once a Mass has been said by the St. Joan of Arc priests, the intention will be posted on the letterboard on a weekly basis.

Wall in choir loft: a dividing wall has been installed in the choir loft to allow for a separate space to be used as a classroom for catechism classes.

Marian Devotions Recommended by St. Alphonsus Liguori

- 1. Recite at least five decades of the Rosary every day
- Fast in honor of the Blessed Virgin (every Saturday and on vigils of her principal feasts).
- Recite Angelus three times a day; salute her frequently during the day with an Ave Maria, particularly when you hear the clock strike, or when you see an image of the Virgin, and also when you leave or return to your house.
- 4. Say the Litany of the Blessed Virgin every evening before you go to bed; keep an image of Mary near your bed.
- 5. Wear the scapular (Black or Brown)
- 6. Recommend yourself frequently to her prayers. Never forget to say three Hail Marys in the morning, to beg of her to preserve you from sin during the day.

Scapular enrollment: will be **Saturday February 10** immediately after the 8 am Mass (~8:45 am) for St. Joan of Arc parishioners who have made their First Communion and have never been enrolled in the scapular. As with baptism, enrollment in the scapular is only necessary once in your life.

Mass for the FSSP: All Fraternity parishes, including St. Joan of Arc, will offer Mass for the FSSP on the second Sunday of each month. The 5 pm Mass will have the intention for the Fraternity.

Safe Environment class: for those who missed the first class, there will be at second Safe Environment training at 6:30 pm **Friday February 16** in the parish hall. This class is for those who have not had an **in person** class for their SEW certification. This is required for all employees and volunteers 18 yrs. and over who work/help out at the parish. Spiritual readings for Lent

Great means of sanctification come from spiritual reading, especially reading *Sacred Scripture*, the *masters of the interior life* (St. John of the Cross, St. Teresa of Avila, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Alphonsus Liguori, St. Alphonsus Rodriguez, Tauler, etc.), and the *lives of the Saints*. Some works are **theological** (teaching doctrine), some are **spiritual** (describing the interior life), and others are **devotional** (motivation to grow in the spiritual life). The **Gospels** take priority, as they contain for us special graces that incline us more to the imitate the virtues of Christ. After this comes the Acts of the Apostles (the "Lives of the Original Saints"), and the Epistles.

The **Epistles and Old Testament** can be used to learn about the following:

The Person and work of Christ: Colossians 1
The splendor of the life of the Church: Ephesians
1-3

Justification: Romans 1-11

Priesthood of Christ: Hebrews 1-9

<u>Duties of Christians regarding the Church</u>: 1 Peter 4

Prayer: The Psalms

<u>Interior Souls</u>: The works of the prophets; Books of Wisdom

<u>Practical guidance to learn wisdom:</u> Proverbs, Ecclesiasticus

The works of the Saints and spiritual classics are most helpful:

<u>St. Augustine</u>: Confessions (for conversion) <u>St. Gregory the Great</u>: Exposition on the Book of

Job

<u>Cassian</u>: Conferences on the Desert Fathers <u>Richard of St. Victor</u>: Benjamin Minor and Benjamin Major; Exposition on the Song of Songs

(on the interior life)

Blessed Hugh of St. Cher: On the Spiritual Life

St. Albert the Great: Commentary on Sacred Scripture

St. Catherine of Siena: Dialogues

<u>Thomas a Kempis</u>: Imitation of Christ (to get motivated; not recommended for the scrupulous)

St. Alphonsus Liguori: Anything by him, esp. 12

Steps to Holiness; Victories of the Martyrs

<u>Francisco de Osuna</u>: Third Spiritual Alphabet

<u>St. John of the Cross</u>: Ascent of Mt. Carmel

<u>St. Teresa of Avila</u>: The Way of Perfection (for interior souls)

There are **more recent devotional books** which are very good:

<u>Jesus Our Eucharistic Love</u>: Fr. Stephano Manelli

<u>The Book of Confidence</u>: Fr. Laurent (for those struggling with confidence in God)

<u>Searching</u> for and <u>Maintaining Peace</u>: Fr. Philippe (to keep peace in the midst of difficulty)

<u>How to Profit from Your Faults</u>: Fr. Tissot <u>Works of Fr. Faber</u>: Various good devotional works

<u>Works of Fr. Eugene Boylan</u>: Various good devotional works

For children, these books are very good:

<u>The Three Talking Trees</u>: Francis Timoney (get the older version, without 'inclusive language')

St. Paul Editions Books: Lives of the saints books by the Daughters of St. Paul

My Picture Book of Saints: A classic

Children's Bible: Illustrated Bible for children
